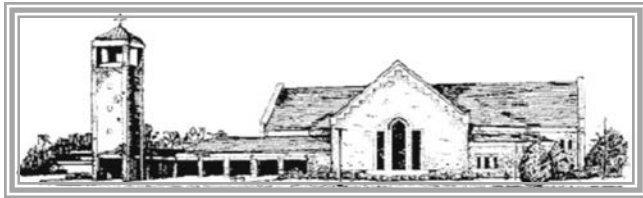

**Good Friday:** March 30, 5:30 p.m., Celebration of the Lord's Passion.

**Easter Sunday:** April 1, Masses at 8:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

**PALM SUNDAY LITURGIES:** Please note a slight schedule change for the Masses on Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week (this year the weekend of March 24-25). Due to the length of the Masses that day and the need for musicians to prepare for the liturgies, there will **NOT** be an 8:00 a.m. Mass on Palm Sunday, March 25. There will be the usual Mass on Saturday, March 24, 4:30 p.m. as well as the usual 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. Masses on Sunday, March 25. This is only for that weekend, Palm Sunday.
