We look forward to the liturgical celebrations of Holy Week, through which the Lord draws us more fully into the mystery of His death and resurrection.

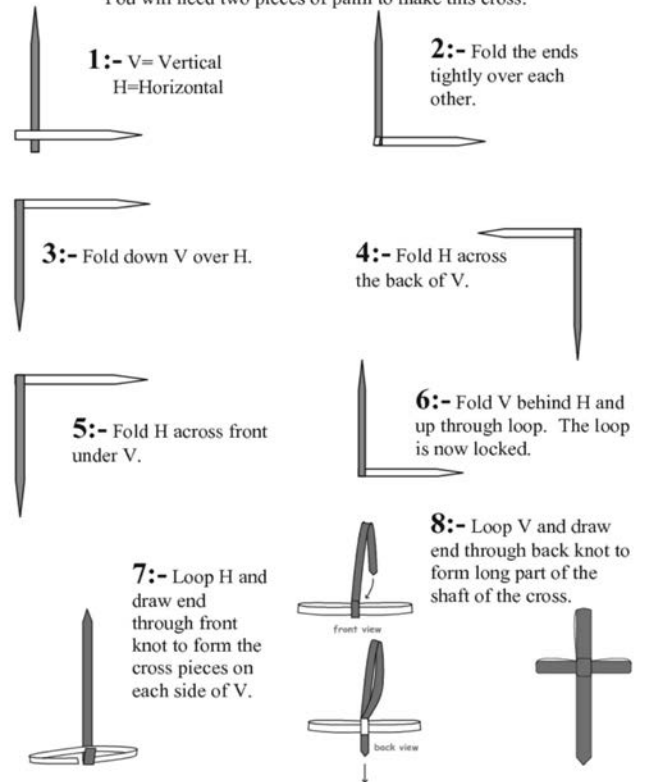
**Dominican Faith Camp Registration Now Open**
