We look forward to the liturgical celebrations of Holy Week, through which the Lord draws us more fully into the mystery of His death and resurrection.

In last Sunday's bulletin (April 2), our parochial vicar, Fr. Daren, announced to the parish that Bishop Paprocki has assigned him to be pastor of St. Augustine Parish in Ashland, effective August 1. He also indicated the other diocesan responsibilities that the Bishop has changed or assigned to him. Though among us only briefly since July of last year, I am grateful for his willing help and frankly, his friendly company.

Though you will see it officially in next Sunday's issue of the *Catholic Times*, (April 16) Bishop Paprocki has assigned Fr. Pawel Augustyniak to our parish as a parochial vicar (assistant priest) effective August 1. Fr. Pawel is from the Diocese of Radom in Poland. He has a degree in canon (Church) law and will also serve as a judge on our Diocesan Tribunal. Fr. Pawel is one of several international priests now serving in our diocese. (I'll have to brush up on what few Polish words I know—"witamy" (welcome!) and pierogi!)

On a different note, with this being Palm Sunday, we have entered Holy Week 2017. I call your attention to the schedule of liturgies for the Paschal Triduum, especially the Vigil of Easter (Holy Saturday, April 15, 8:00 p.m.) during which we will here at St. Agnes welcome into the Catholic Church, Katie Mayland. Katie is one of 319 catechumens and candidates across our diocese being welcomed into the Church this Easter. Come to this first and richest of the Easter Masses!

HOW TO MAKE A PALM CROSS

You will need two pieces of palm to make this cross.

- 1:- V= Vertical
H=Horizontal
- 2:- Fold the ends tightly over each other.
- 3:- Fold down V over H.
- 4:- Fold H across the back of V.
- 5:- Fold H across front under V.
- 6:- Fold V behind H and up through loop. The loop is now locked.
- 7:- Loop H and draw end through front knot to form the cross pieces on each side of V.
- 8:- Loop V and draw end through back knot to form long part of the shaft of the cross.
