## LETTER FROM THE BISHOP (Catholic Home Missions Appeal)

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Here in the United States there is a great need for spreading the Gospel and sharing the message of Christ and the beauty of the Church. The Church at home needs to be strengthened and fortified. Soon, as a diocese, we will take up the Catholic Home Missions Appeal, (CHMA), which supports the neediest dioceses in the United States.
