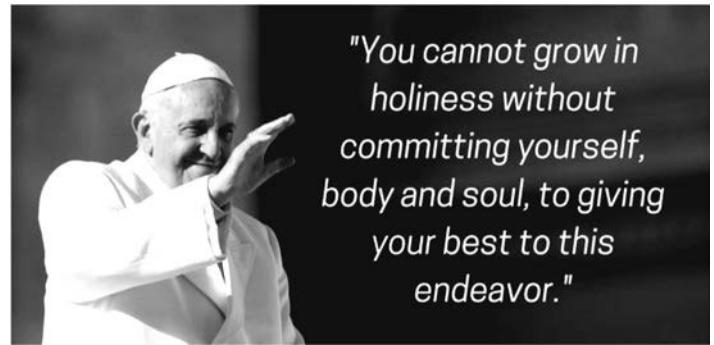


### RIGHT TO LIFE CORNER
