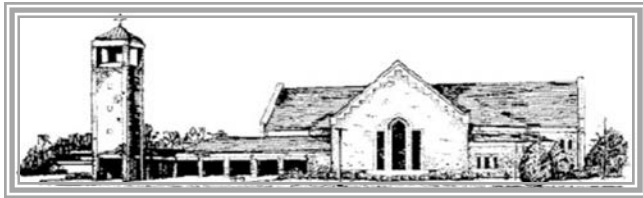

Extend TPS for Haitians: An estimated 58,000 Haitians are at risk of having their Temporary Protected Status (TPS) terminated by the Department of Homeland Security. TPS allows these individuals to temporarily remain in the United States and support themselves legally while Haiti is being rebuilt. Haiti is still recovering from the devastation of Hurricane Matthew, which struck in October 2016. Additionally, Haiti is plagued with a severe cholera epidemic and food shortages. Given these persistent conditions, terminating TPS would be inhumane and untenable. Unfortunately, there are reports that some government officials are recommending that TPS be terminated for Haitians. Go to <https://justiceforimmigrants.org/> and click on Take Action to ask Homeland Security Secretary, John Kelly to extend TPS.
