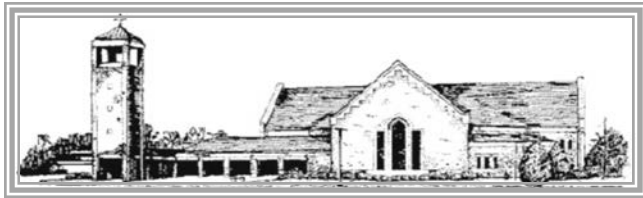

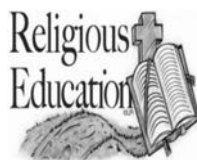
Are You Experiencing the Pain of Separation or Divorce?
