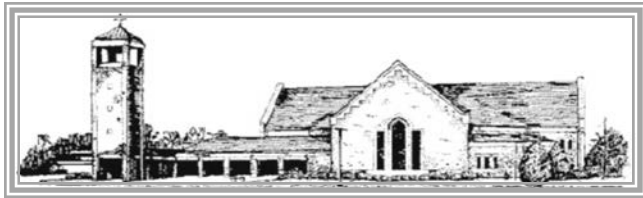

Dear St. Agnes Parishioners,

Recently our parish concluded a five-week planning study to look into the possibility of a capital campaign to address some needed projects as well as debt relief and increased Sunday offering. The Steier Group from Omaha, NE, conducted this very thorough study and the conclusion is that there is support for such a campaign and parishioners are eager to get it off the ground.

Over 200 mail surveys were returned and 73 persons or couples were interviewed. Besides increased offering, projects supported were a new church/parish hall/office roof, replacing of a school AC chiller and 2 boilers, upgrading of parish/school phone system and a new sound system for the church. Through the Steier Groups calculations, we should be able to raise anywhere from 1.4 to 1.8 million dollars for such needs.

Groundwork for such a campaign is now taking place and a campaign will begin after the new year in January, slated to conclude on March 29.

Your time and interest in sharing your reflections were essential and appreciated.

This week we celebrate one of our favorite American holidays – Thanksgiving. We have much to be thankful for as a community of faith that is St. Agnes. Let the gifts given us by a generous God be generously shared as well.

Blessings to you and your loved ones as we enter the holiday season.
