A message from Fr. Dan

Today's Feast is steeped both in Scripture and Legend. Suffice to say that Important People of Wealth from the Eastern (non-Jewish) world recognized the CHRIST (Savior) of the Jews as an astonishing event. This large caravan traveled 546 miles from Modern Day Baghdad to Jerusalem. They carried everything they would need traveling about 10 miles a night (too hot in daytime) navigating by the stars. 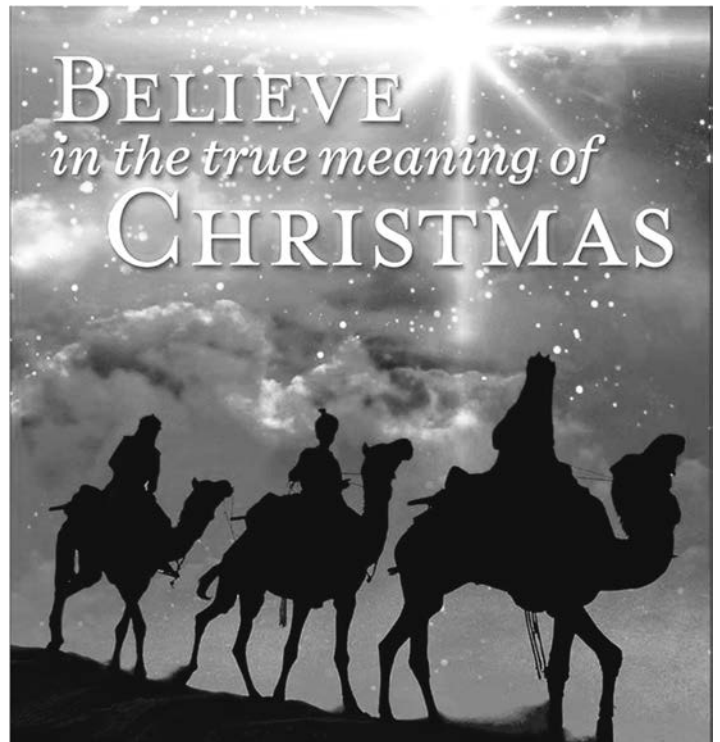
