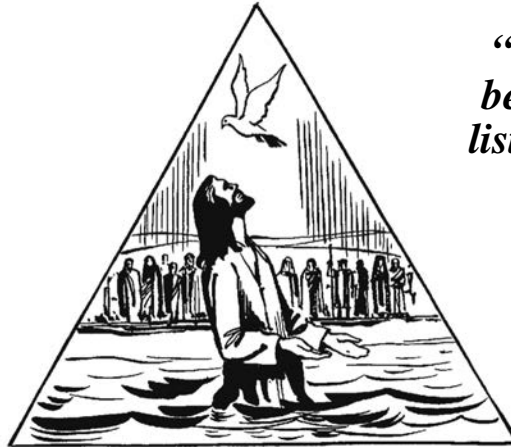

Mass Intentions

While a priest may only accept one intention at a single Mass, he may have many other intentions not attached to an offering. In addition, the faithful may bring their own intentions to the Mass, which they each carry privately and spiritually in prayer. Mass Intentions are scheduled first come. Intentions can only be scheduled up to a year in advance and only one per month per individual. Mass schedules fill up fast (usually 6-8 months in advance) and specific dates may not be available. A Mass stipend of \$10 is suggested but more may be offered. *Please Note: If a Mass is cancelled for any reason, we will do our best to let the family know of the cancellation. 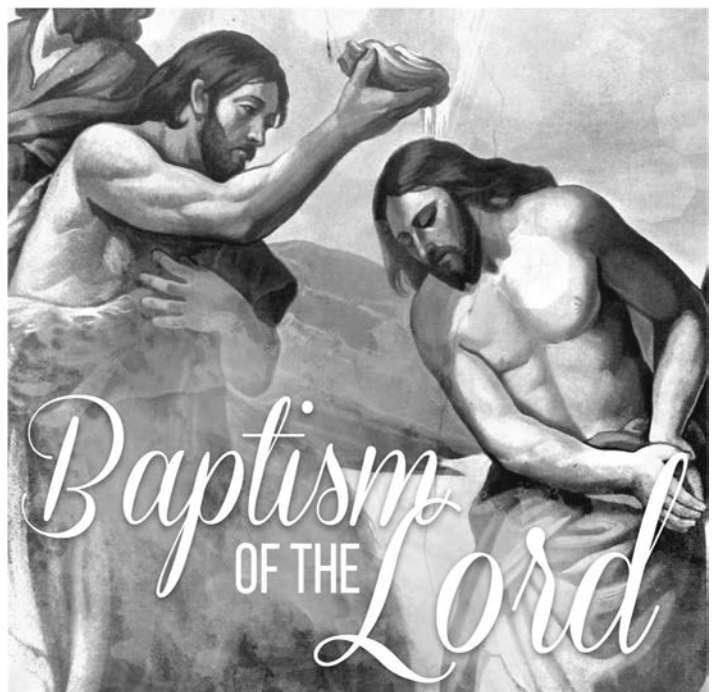
