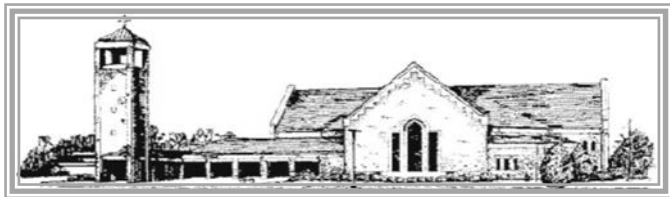

Easter Sunday: April 21, Masses at 8:00 a.m., 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

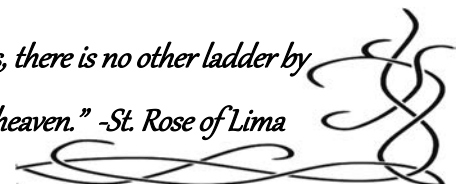
