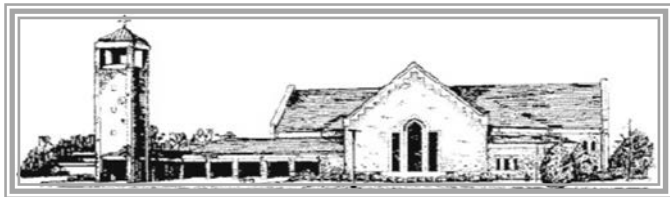

Indeed, you have been my home within my hometown itself! And because of those virtues just mentioned, you will do well as you journey into the future which God calls you to.

This has to mean something then as we are a people of Easter faith no matter where we are.
