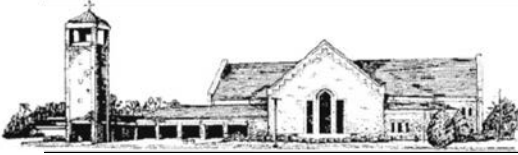

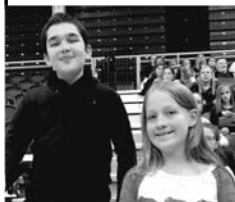
OCTOBER FOOD DRIVE
